

## Südkulturfonds: Open Call *100artists* 2022

*100artists* was a response to the mobility restrictions caused by the pandemic, which made it extremely difficult for artists from the Global South and East and Swiss organisers to travel. An international jury selected 100 artists (individuals and collectives) from 619 candidates who submitted a video and samples of their work. The prize money per artist was CHF 1'000.

The selection was made public and distributed among Swiss organisers. In this way, *100artists* drew attention to the diversity of artistic creation in the Global South and East. In addition, the aim was to strengthen the professional and financial existence of 100 selected artists from various disciplines at an early stage of their careers. The open call *100artists* included all artistic disciplines. Of the 100 winners, 28 artists are from the visual arts, 16 from music, 14 from literature and spoken word, 11 each from theatre, interdisciplinarity and film, and 9 from dance.
