rezzan gümgüm's research conducted during the Berlin Senate Residency program, as part of her ongoing long-term artistic investigation. It delves into the individual and collective experiences of women, who migrated from Dersim region to Berlin, at different times. Drawing on face-to-face interviews, academic studies, and relevant literature, the works explore issues of language and recognition in the identity-building processes of Kurdish women. Through video and installations, the exhibition highlights the destructive impact of state violence on both nature and humanity. It also examines how displacement alters relationships with space, affects memory, and leads to the loss of everyday rituals and the knowledge carried through millennia.

Performance

When mourning is suppressed, neither the confrontation of pain nor the process of healing can occur. The normalization of violence and oppression deprives communities of their right to collective mourning, leading to a fractured sense of time. This performance explores both the individual and societal dimensions of suppressed grief, questioning the invisibility of pain and the normalization of violence against both nature and human beings.

"My / Red Lines" exhibits the recording of a long-term performance done by rezzan gümgüm in Ankara in 2019, displaying videos, photographs, and site-specific installations. Over two months in Ankara, intermittent performances were accompanied by pouring red paint from a plastic bottle onto the ground, creating "red lines" that spread across the city streets. These red lines, formed by paint, echo the longstanding rhetoric of "our red line" voiced by authorities, reappears, represented on the streets, and are encouraged to be stepped upon. The lines, that accompany the routines of daily life, are repeatedly violated by urban dwellers. Representing boundaries imposed on geography, gender, body, language, thought, action, rights, and freedom, these "red lines" provoke a reconsideration and discussion of coping tactics within the enchantment of the streets amidst all these pressures and encroachments. They call everyone to take part in the aesthetics of the game of resisting.

Two drone-shot videos that depict the geography of Dersim area accompanied with the video showing the artist doing the performance of drinking water that spring from the mountains in the region. The water that feeds the area is symbolically referred as the breast milk of a mother.

This installation consists of two videos and an installation. The video on the circular surface on the ground displays the animation of red spotted trouts swimming/dancing to the rhythm of the music of the string instrument. This species are believed to the ritual of "cem" in the culture of Dersim region. The objects on the other circular surface are collected from the places that are considered sacred. Rocks and a goat horn are covered with the string that are cut from emergency blankets and crocheted by the artist. The other video show the artist performing the ritual that is done when any living or non-living thing is taken from the nature. This is called "taking consent" from the nature.

The elder lady recalls the atrocities during her childhood done by the authorities, as well as the local families. The language spoken by the ladies are categorized as "unknown" by the authorities in the country.




### I Have Treasures on the Margin

This study presents a research workshop that collects and records the materials of human activities and examines the plants of the uncontrolled area. It brings together a number of objects and visual notes related to the recent past of Dikmen Valley, located in the center of Ankara, that will activate the participants' own memories. I Have Treasures on the Margin invites you to witness an ongoing walking process, to meet the audience with original observations of space and time, and to participate in planned walks. I Have Treasures on the Margin offers to share the experience of a process which is different from regular exhibitions. The walks that start by creating a route in Dikmen valley are explored as a performative and conceptual experience of mobility and memory.
